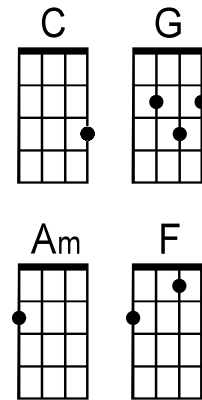


"Redemption Song" by Bob Marley
