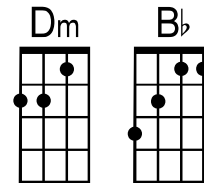

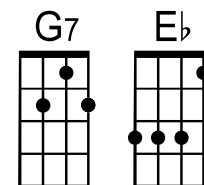
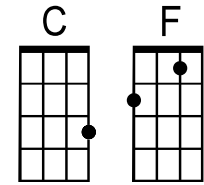
## CHORUS:

## Verse 1:

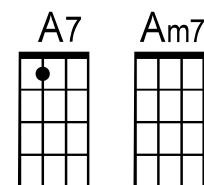
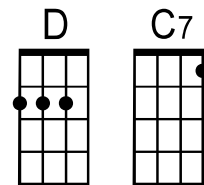
**Bb** **C** **F** **Bb**
